

Tenure Track Position in Algebra

- Position:** One tenure-track Assistant Professor position, Department of Mathematics, College of Arts and Sciences, University of Nebraska-Lincoln.
- Qualifications:** The successful candidate should have a Ph.D. in mathematics and potential for teaching and research in mathematics at a research university. Preference will be given to applicants who show strong research promise in areas of algebra that complement and extend the strengths of the Department.
- Starting Date:** August 2012
- First Review:** Review of applications will begin November 30, 2011, and continue until a suitable candidate has been selected.
- Duties/Responsibilities:** Teaching responsibilities include graduate and undergraduate courses in mathematics. The ideal candidate will be able to establish a strong, independent research program in algebra.
- Salary/Benefits:** A competitive starting salary will be negotiated. UNL makes available life, health, and long-term disability insurance programs as well as family coverage at reasonable group rates to the employee. TIAA/CREF and/or Fidelity Investment Fund are offered as retirement plans.
