

Instructions for Adding Printers in Math Department to Ubuntu Machines

GradLab-Left

1. Go to System>Administration>Printers
2. Click on "Add+c" to add a printer.
3. Click on "Network Printer" and then click on "Find Network Printer".
4. In the host line, type "mathstat.unl.edu" (without the quotes).
5. Now in the panel on the left side of the application box, click on "Printer in High-Tech Classroom".
6. In the queue textbox, delete "color" and add "left".
7. Click on "Verify".
8. Click on "Forward".
9. Wait while it searches for drivers.
10. In the next screen, choose "HP".
11. In the list of models, choose "Laserjet p3005x".
12. Then select the recommended driver.
13. Once again click "Forward".
14. Give the printer the name you want to show on your computer under "Printer Name", and then click "Apply".

GradLab-Right

1. Replace "left" in line 6, with "right" and follow the same instructions as above.

Ugradlab

1. Go to System>Administration>Printers
2. Click on "Add+c" to add a printer.
3. Click on "Network Printer" and then click on "Find Network Printer".
4. In the host line, type "mathstat.unl.edu" (without the quotes).
5. Now in the panel on the left side of the application box, click on "Printer in High-Tech Classroom".
6. In the queue textbox, delete "gradlab-color" and add "ugradlab".
7. Click on "Verify".
8. Click on "Forward".
9. Wait while it searches for drivers.
10. In the next screen, choose "HP".
11. In the list of models, choose "Laserjet 4050N".
12. Then select the recommended driver.
13. Once again click "Forward".
14. Give the printer the name you want to show on your computer under "Printer Name", and then click "Apply".
